#### Becoming A Resilient Mother

Elizabeth arrived at MOPS in one of her few sets of clothes. She sat there numb and overcome as gifts were set before her. It seemed like yesterday that she spoke at the annual tea, and celebrated her infant son surviving a life-threatening medical trial. She dried a tear as it trickled down her cheek, wishing she could wipe away the fact she'd just lost her home in a horrific wildfire a couple weeks earlier. Instead of leading as she had for five years, now MOPS would become her family during this critical time.

As weeks flew by, people asked how her family remained close and seemed joyful. The reality of "beauty from ashes" truly happened. In this session, Elizabeth shares tips for gaining a sense of purpose beyond circumstances and tapping into greater meaning in life that helps moms persevere through trials.

As she entered the local grocery, police surrounded a man and woman next to Elizabeth and her young son. Her son was responsive to her shouting "Get DOWN!" and listened well to her direction as three groups of professional thieves were caught in their midst. When asked why he remained so calm, her son said it was like the book they were listening to on audio - and he wanted to protect her and keep her safe.

The power of story has really helped Elizabeth teach her children to face challenges like bullying, anguish over moving a lot and repeatedly losing their "stuff" to thieves and a wildfire. What if the stories you listen to and the atmosphere you create at home could help save your life at a critical moment - and shape character into your loved ones?
